

2023 Tillamook Burn Net Control Records

We have tried developing several kinds of tracking sheets, but each net control operator likes to record this information differently. How you record is up to you, but these are the pieces of information that you will need to keep.

BEGINNING OF RACE

After race start, ask race director for the total number of runners on the course as well as the list of bib numbers of runners who did not start. It can take up to an hour or more for the race director or registration volunteer to get this information for you. You will **need to transmit these to all of the aid stations** as they come online so that their volunteers can cross the non-starters off the list of bibs they are looking for.

AID STATION REPORTS

You will need to record the bib numbers and times of the first male and female runners through each aid station. You will also want to try and record the bib number and time of the last runner through each aid station, as well as when the sweepers left each aid station.

DROPS

You will need to record the bib number of every person who drops from the race, the aid station they dropped from, the time they dropped, and their method of being evacuated from the course (ride with crew, ride with volunteer, ride with medical - etc). Make sure that when new stations come online they have the full list of bib numbers of dropped runners. Net control is the clearing house for this information, so good notes are vital!
